Sarah Byrne's savvy adulterations of sound and pop film are on show from October 31st at No Frills* Artist-Run Initiative. Byrne's ambitious video installation for No Frills* interferes with favourite clay humanoid, Gumby in a typically demented cadence of noise and image. Byrne incessantly circumvents the psychological experience of the work through a treatment of sound that borders on the sadistic. This cunning assault is not to be missed.

Byrne's latest shows at the Institute of Modern Art, FirstDraft (Sydney) and various independent projects around Brisbane situate her as one of Brisbane most important emerging artists. Byrne is also a Co-Director of *inbetweenspaces*, an Artist-Run Initiative capitalising on Brisbane's vacant spaces (www.inbetweenspaces.org). She also bears an uncanny resemblance to Molly Ringwald.
